1 CASE CONFERENCE REPORT - Hazel Talbot

pr. Imelda Ryan's report of October 3rd refers to this case. Dr. Ryan is very concerned about the family situation. Hazel has returned home from her grandparents. She is saying father is very difficult to get on with. Mother agrees but does not want him to leave. Hazel is very disturbed, does not like father and wants him out of the house. Dr. Ryan feels this may be a plot on the Hazel's part. Hazel suggests she will do something to herself if the situation to does not change. She is not in touch with her own feelings. She now describes a good relationship with her brothers. She is doing well in schooland is very involved in a local theatre group.

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Father

has admitted to being oversexual towards Hazel in the past.

This is a very disturbed family who need help, they are all under an enormous ψ_0 strain and playing very dangerous games. Powerful controls are needed over them. There are implications for the younger children also. The sexual abuse is called "it" all the time and this has never been disclosed.

Decisions

Pr. Ryan will see Hazel on December 7th and will put to Hazel that herself and Rosemary will hold a joint interview with her and her parents. The Gardai will have to be involved - to try to maintain a control over the family.

Joint interview to be arranged (Imelda and Rosemary) - Rosemary being present to obtain an objective sense of the situation. The Gardai will be held until after this meeting.
